

Cereal Box Project

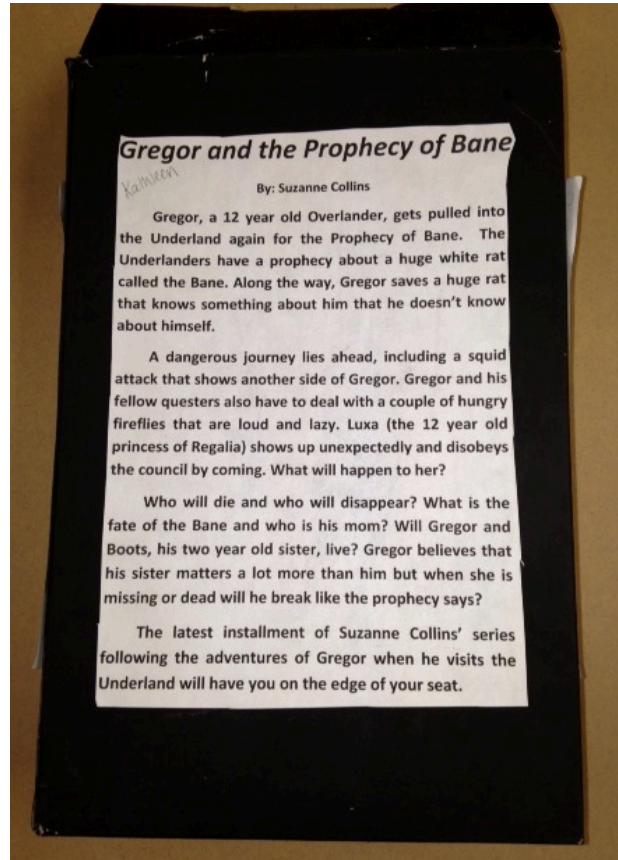
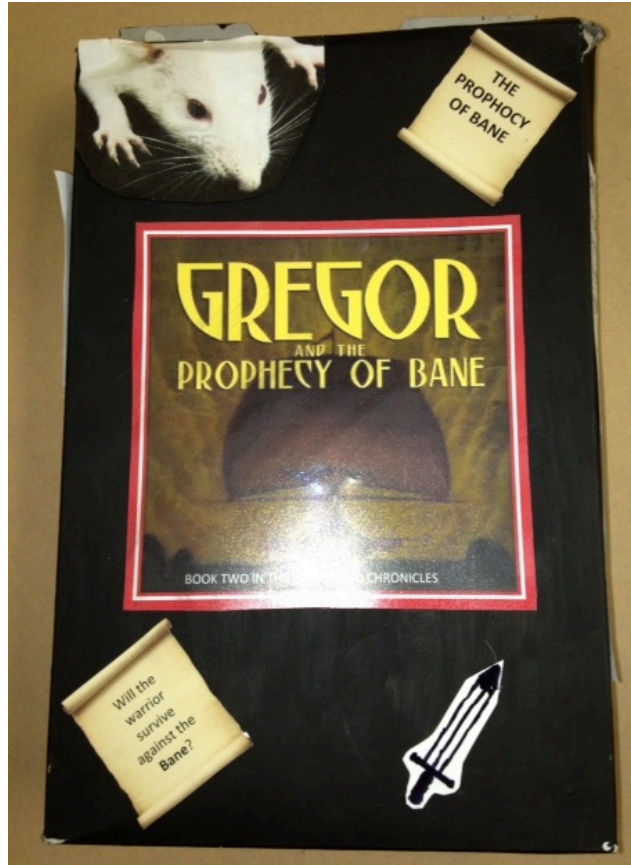


This project will require you to create a cereal box project in order to capture the elements of your novel.

Requirements:

1. Use a piece of paper to cover each face of the cereal box. You will probably want to create each part before gluing it on the box.
2. Front of Box: Include the name of the book, author, your name, and illustration.
3. Right Side: Include a list of the main characters and 3-4 sentences about each character.
4. Left Side: Include a short description of the setting. This section should be 6-8 sentences.
5. Back of Box: Write a summary that describes the main problem and solution of the book. Try to use words that will “grab” readers’ attention and make them want to read your book. Your summary should consist of 12-16 sentences.
6. Top of Box: Rate your book out of 5 stars. Then write 3-4 sentences explaining why you rated it how you did.

Front of Box (title, author, name, and illustration)	Attempted to decorate box, but is missing a lot of information (title, author, student name). Little effort went into the decoration of the box.	Decorated the box, but is missing some information (title, author, student name). Decoration took some effort, but did not attract the viewer's interest.	Decorated the box so that it is visually interesting and reflected the content of the book. Included at least 2 pieces of key information (author, title, student name).	Included all 3 pieces of key information (author, title, student name). Decorated the box clearly, took time, and put forth effort.
Right Side (main characters)	Listed only the main character.	Listed the main characters.	Listed all the main characters and included less than 3 sentences about each one.	Listed all the main characters and included at least 3-4 sentences about each one.
Left Side (setting)	Attempted to describe the setting, but neglected to include complete sentences.	Wrote 1-2 sentences about the setting. Did not include information about the time period, place(s), and/or conditions. There were no descriptive details about the setting.	Described the setting, but may have neglected to mention the time period or condition. There were a few descriptive sentences about the setting.	The setting was described with vivid details. Time, condition, and location were all mentioned.
Back (summary)	Attempted a summary, but neglected to include a beginning, middle, and end.	Included a beginning, middle, and end, but included too many irrelevant details. There were incomplete sentences and/or major grammatical errors.	Included a beginning, middle, and end and very few irrelevant details. Summary was written mostly in complete sentences with few grammatical errors.	Wrote about the beginning, middle, and end and omitted irrelevant details. Summary was in complete sentences with no grammatical errors. Included at least 12-16 sentences.
Top (rating)	Included a rating for the book, but neglected to explain the rating.	Included a rating for the book and only 1 sentence explaining the rating.	Included a rating for the book and only 2 sentences explaining the rating.	Included a rating for the book and at least 3-4 sentences explaining the rating.
