Haiku

Haiku: a Japanese poem that is a three-line poem with seventeen syllables, written in a **5/7/5** syllable count. Often focusing on images from nature, haiku emphasizes simplicity, intensity, and directness of expression.

Examples:

An old silent pond...

A frog jumps into the pond, splash! Silence again.
