## T-shirt Book report



This project will require you to create a t-shirt to promote your book's popularity. Your t-shirt should be designed to increase interest in the book. It should be visually appealing and accurately portray the plot of the book.

## Requirements:

- 1. <u>Front of the Shirt:</u> Include the book title, author, and a descriptive illustration of the main conflict. This should be an original design, NOT SOMETHING YOU FOUND AND PRINTED FROM THE INTERNET!
- 2. Back of Shirt: Include an illustration of a solution to the conflict.
- 3. Be sure to color and decorate your work! You can use iron-ons, Sharpies, fabric paint, or other materials to bring your shirt to life!
- 4. <u>Summary:</u> On a separate sheet of paper, type a three-paragraph summary of your book. Each paragraph should be 6-8 sentences.
  - a.  $1^{st}$  paragraph: Information about the exposition and rising action.
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph: Information about the main conflict and climax.
  - c. 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph: Explain the resolution and falling action.
- 5. Remember spelling, punctuation, and grammar count!
